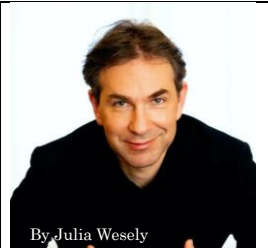
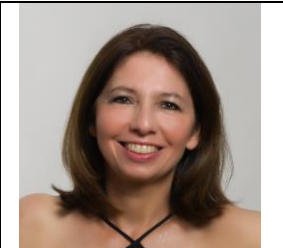

*The fee will cover the course, admissions for concerts and open lessons.

*There will be no master classes on August 17th and the 30th, but there will be concerts, so you can listen to them.

* When entering the concert, we may guide you to the chorus seats on busy days. Also, please refrain from bringing preschoolers with you.

*The master class is scheduled to be held from August 18th to the 29th, but please be aware that the start and end dates of the master class may differ depending on the class. In addition, the cancellation date for each class is undecided until just before, so please check the official website or at the Academy office on site.

Accommodation

Those who wish to apply for accommodation through the academy office can also apply for accommodation at the time of the application. Please note that the **deadline to apply for accommodations is 16:00(JST), Wednesday, June 11th**, which is before the long-term attendance application deadline. Please note that if the number of applications exceeds the number of rooms, full-term students have priority and some students may be asked to arrange their own accommodation. In addition, in the event an absence is inevitable, the accommodation fee for that date must still be paid.
